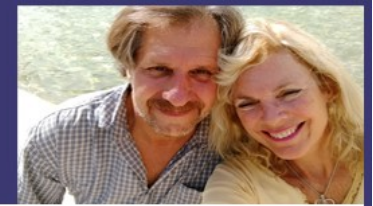

"Call to the Land of Israel Tour"

11 Day Tour with Robert & Marcelyn Brecka



Day 1- Friday, May 18th 2018: Welcome to Israel

Arrive in Israel in the morning at Ben Gurion airport; be greeted by your Israeli Tour guide, and your Israeli Hosts Robert and Marcelyn. We board our motor coach to visit Independence Hall in Tel Aviv where the nation of Israel was born in dramatic circumstances. We proceed to visit Jaffa, the departing place of the Prophet Jonah and here we also see the house of Simon the tanner where Peter had his vision. We continue now to our hotel on the Mediterranean Shores and have time to take a walk on the beach and/or swim in the sea or pool. Enjoy a Shabbat dinner! *Overnight: Tel-Aviv Hotel*

Day 2- Saturday, May 19th 2018: Galilee Shores

After a gourmet buffet breakfast, we begin this morning by driving up the Mediterranean coast to Mount Carmel area where the prophet Elijah slew the prophets of Baal. Continue to Mount Carmel Assembly service where we'll participate in the present day Messianic Jewish Assembly. After lunch, we drive through the Valley of Jezreel, the prophetic future site of Armageddon. We proceed to Nazareth where Yeshua grew up and see the ancient synagogue where He stood up and said, "The Spirit of Yahvey is upon me..." as in Isaiah 61. We will drive up to Mount Precipice overlooking the Jezreel Valley. *Overnight: Galilee Shores Hotel with a prayer & praise special dinner overlooking the Sea of Galilee*

Day 3- Sunday, May 20th 2018: Explore The Galilee and Pray in the Golan Area

After a hearty Israeli breakfast buffet on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, step aboard the praise boat for a calm cruise across the sea and an exhilarating worship service with Daniel Carmel. At Nof Ginosaur, see an ancient preserved boat used by fishermen in Yashua's time 2000 years ago. In Magdala we visit the recently discovered archaeological remains of the town of Mary Magdelyn. Then to Tabgha, the place where Yeshua multiplied the fishes and loaves. Then onto the Mount of Beatitudes where we hear the words of Yeshua on the mount where He first spoke to the people overlooking the Galilee. We stop for a St. Peter's fish luncheon included in your tour. We finish this day touring upon the Golan Heights; the strategic mountains of northern Israel. Relax, swim and enjoy dinner at the hotel. *Overnight: Galilee Shores Hotel*

Day 4 - Monday, May 21st 2018: Through the Jordan Valley to the Dead Sea

We begin this morning at the Jordan River baptism site, where those that would like can be baptized. We travel south along the Jordan River Valley to the site of Qumran where the caves of the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered by a shepherd boy and see the ruins of the ancient Essene Village. Lunch at the museum. We arrive at our Dead Sea Hotel in the afternoon and float on the Dead Sea waters at the beach. Enjoy the outdoor swimming pool, and Indoor warm mineral facilities, along with optional spa facilities. Enjoy your hotel sunset dinner.

Day 5 - Tuesday, May 22nd 2018: Dead Sea to Oasis tents

Awake for an early morning optional float on the Dead Sea for those looking for the sunrise. Continue to Ein Gedi with a walk to the desert waterfall where David was inspired to write verses in the Psalms while hiding from King Saul. Continue toward Masada through the wilderness of Judea where you will ascend by cable car to the fortress built by King Herod the Great. See the remains of Herod's Palace, the Apartments, Baths, Storehouses and cisterns. It was here the Jewish Zealots made their last stand revolt against the Roman Legions from 70-73 AD. Relive the times in a dramatic museum tour. From here we view Gomorrah, a city destroyed by fire and brimstone in the book of Genesis. Descend from Masada by cable car with a stunning view of the Dead Sea. We then ascend to the high desert for a visit to the Fountain of Tears in Arad; life size bronze sculptures that uniquely reconcile the cross and the Holocaust. Then onto a camel ride where we enjoy a Bedouin hospitality reception and dinner at Kfar Hanokdim in accommodations under 5 billion stars! Enjoy an outdoor bonfire with praise and song led by local worshippers!

Day 6 - Wednesday, May 23rd 2018: Northern Negev & the Judean Hills

Awaken to the birdsongs of your desert oasis and travel to Tel Arad where Moses destroyed a Canaanite city during the time of Exodus. Then to Susiya, an archeological site of a Jewish community, which existed for 8 centuries after the destruction of the Second Temple with impressive synagogue and mosaics. Onto Har Amasa, the unique mountain top community and home of Robert and Marcelyn located on an ancient trail. See a community under redevelopment in the negev. On our way now to Jerusalem, we visit the Valley of Elah, where David defeated Goliath. Ascend to Jerusalem and welcome to the City of Gold! This evening we relax at our hotel with a spectacular Israeli dinner and will delight in our beautiful first night in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - Thursday, May 24th 2018: Jerusalem, Jewish Heart

Begin the tour today at Zion Gate in the Old City, then proceed to the Jewish Quarter and also visit the Temple Institute where preparations are being made for the Third Temple. Garments and Instruments can be seen and the lecture is informative. Continue through the Jewish Quarter of the city to see Nehemiah's Wall that was fortified by the Jews during the period 586 B.C.. We'll visit the Burnt House Museum with its dramatic presentation and have lunch in the Jewish Quarter. Pray at the Western Wall and the Southern Steps of the Temple where Yeshua walked with His disciples. On to the city of David where King David's palace has been discovered and walk through ancient 2700-3500 year old tunnels; enjoy the film presentation. Worship time in the City of David before departing. Dinner at the Yehuda

Day 8 - Friday, May 25th 2018: Israel Museum & Old City

Our 2nd Day in Jerusalem we go to the Shrine of the Book Museum to view the oldest known scroll of the book of Isaiah the prophet; then onto the Israel Museum where we view the Dead Sea Scrolls. View the Holy Land Model of the City of Jerusalem as it was in the time of Yeshua. Lunch at the museum. Visit the Old City with your choice of: tea time at Christ Church, ramparts walk on top of the ancient city walls, shopping in the Old City and / or visiting the David Citadel Museum. At the end Afternoon worship in Jerusalem's premier 24 hour praise and worship place!

Day 9 - Saturday, May 26th 2018: Jerusalem, Mount of Olives. Walking in the Footsteps of Yashua's

We drive to the Mount of Olives where you see a panoramic view of Jerusalem where biblical events come into perspective. We walk down to the Garden of Gethsemane where Yeshua was arrested and view the Eastern Gate and pray looking at the prophesied place of HIS return to Jerusalem. We continue to St Peter's Church where Yeshua was tried at the House of Caiaphas. Lunch in the Old City. Then onto The Pavement, where Yeshua was judged and scourged by Pilate, and to the Garden Tomb at Gordon's Calvary and Golgotha, where Yeshua was crucified, buried and resurrected! We have communion together in front of the empty tomb. Dinner at Yehuda Hotel.

Day 10 - Sunday, May 27th 2018: The Biblical Heartland

We begin this day by visiting Shiloh, the first capitol of the tribes, and present day settlement, and see where the Tabernacle stood for 369 years in the times of the Judges. Here we see a dramatic movie presentation and pray. Visit winery in Samaria. Explore Beth El where Yah spoke to Abraham and Jacob in a dream about the covenant land of Israel.

Day 11 - Monday, May 28th 2018: Caesarea & Shalom!

We leave Jerusalem and go up to Yad Hashmona; an historical recreation of agricultural life in a First Century Community and see how wine and oil were made. Onward up the west coast of Our Beloved Israel to the ancient ruins of Caesarea. Visit the Roman city amphitheater where the Apostle Paul stood trial on the Mediterranean. Cornelius, the first Gentile of the Church-age was saved as he met Peter here. Following a movie and a walk on the beach we have our farewell dinner together in Caesarea on the shores and say goodbye to the greatest land on earth whom God has chosen for his own: Israel. From here, we are transferred to the airport to catch your evening flight back to the USA. Shalom to our most life changing trip! Hallelujah!
