- Depart from the Hotel after breakfast - Drive up the Old Damascus Road (St Paul) - Visit the ancient port city of Jaffa (Peter's Vision) - Continue to Caesarea Maritima (where Peter baptized the first Gentile believer & Paul was imprisoned) - Visit Megiddo (Armageddon) - Visit Mt Carmel (where Elijah called down the fire) - Visit El Muhraqa (Spectacular view of the Plains of Armageddon) - Views of Jezreel Valley - Continue to Galilee - Accommodation: Ron Beach, Galilee - Half Board – Breakfast & Evening Meal included	
Day 3 – 7th May	Friday
- Depart from the Hotel after breakfast - Travel to Nazareth - Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation or visit the ruins of Jesus' time - Visit Cana (Jesus' first miracle) - Continue to the Sea of Galilee - Visit Mt of Beatitudes (Sermon on the mount) - Visit Capernaum (The Town of Jesus) - Visit Tabgtha (Loaves & Fishes) - Accommodation: Ron Beach, Galilee – Half Board – Breakfast & Evening Meal included

Depart from the hotel after breakfast	

- Visit the Jesus Boat Museum (praise boat with worship)
- Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee

- Enter the Old City through the Lions Gate - visit the Pools of Bethesda (St Ann's Church)

- Via Dolorosa (Walk of Sorrows)
- Church of Holy Sepulcher
- Visit Mount Zion
- Visit St Peter in Gallicantu (where Peter denied Yeshua 3 times / House of Caiaphas)
- View Ancient steps that Jesus would have used
- Pass through the Jewish Quarter
- View Nehemiah's wall
- Visit the Western Wall (Kotel)
- Accommodation: Prima Kings, Jerusalem - Half Board – Breakfast & Evening Meal included

PLEASE NOTE: The itinerary above is given as a working guide. All sites on the itinerary will be visited but the order in which some sites are visited May be amended to avoid crowds / delays / traffic conditions / revised opening and closing times of sites.

Our guides are in contact with various sites (& other guides) and will co-ordinate the tour to try to avoid delays and utilize the time you have in Israel to its fullest.

As stated above – we will try to ensure that ALL sites are visited but the order in which they are visited may change.

Arrival:

Once flight / arrival times are known for the whole group (*plan for an early evening arrival 18:00 – 21:00 if possible*) then we will decide on the time that the coach will be at the airport for transfer to the first night's hotel. *We will try to arrange the coach to suit as many passenger's flights as possible. If your flight arrives a lot earlier or later than the transfer time we can order a private transfer for you – the cost is around \$50 - \$60 (for up to 4 passengers)

Departure:

On your final day we will ensure that all passengers arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport by 16:00pm (8 day tour). Please try to arrange your flight for early / late evening. You must be at the airport 3 hours before your flight (*so a flight any time after 19:00pm would suit*). If you can only book an earlier flight then we can arrange a private transfer for you – the cost is around \$120 (for up to 4 passengers).

Departure:

On your final day we will ensure that all passengers arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport by 19:00pm (4-day Jordan Extension). Please try to arrange your flight for late evening/early morning. You must be at the airport 3 hours before your flight (*so a flight any time after 22:00pm would suit*). Arrival at the airport may be earlier than 19:00 but delays at the border crossing point MUST be taken into account.

NOTES:

1. The sequence of the tour, hotels used and sites visited may be amended due to circumstances.
2. Reservations received less than 90 days prior to departure are on a request only basis.
3. Prices are based on having a MINIMUM group size of 6 passengers. Below this number will incur an additional supplement (see below)
4. The group size will be between 2 – 30 passengers.

Supplement for below minimum group size:

For a group size of 2 – 5 passengers (total group size): an additional \$375 USD supplement per person will be required. If the total group size (NOT just you party size) is 6 passengers or more, the prices above are valid with NO ADDITIONAL supplement required.

Booking

To book the tour we will require:

- Names of passengers (as shown on passports along with ages on the date of the tour)
- Billing address
- Contact telephone number (that you will have with you in Israel)
- Flight details (once you have them – Flight No's & Arrival / Departure times) – can be added later
- 4-day Jordan Add-on Required: Yes / No?
- Type of room you require

Double = 1 x double bed
Twin = 2 x single beds
Triple = 3 x single beds (or 1 x double bed & 1 x single bed)
Single = 1 x single bed (Single room supplement applies)

Once we receive this information, we will send you through a booking confirmation plus any invoices required for payment of non-refundable deposits to hold rooms. (See payments section below). Closer to the tour date we will also require your passport number & expiry date (for hotels) – for the Petra (add-on) we will also require a scan / photograph of your passport.

PLEASE NOTE: we cannot help with VISA applications (most passengers will fall under the VISA Waiver program so will not require a VISA to enter Israel – this should be checked at your local consulate before booking). Should you require a VISA to enter Israel you will need to apply for this personally at your local consulate. We can provide you with proof of booking onto the tour if required but cannot assist you with personal VISA applications. Since 1st January 2025 all passengers must now apply for and obtain an ETA-IL prior to travelling to Israel. See here for more details: <https://israel-entry.piba.gov.il/>

PAYMENT BREAKDOWN

Payment for the tour should be made in two payments (invoices with payment details will be supplied).

- \$250 Per Person - Deposit (NON-REFUNDABLE) – at time of booking (as one payment via Bank Transfer – invoice will be issued)
- Balance – 12 weeks prior to tour date (as one payment via bank transfer – invoice will be issued)
